Reports from Councils:

- Aligning the withdrawal dealines and pushing the date later into the semestider likely have a positive impact on student success and methods.
 - Faculty have pointed out that0% of the term is for many classes soon to expect students to have received significant feedback on their performance.
- The Integrated Network Council (INC) also submitted heir feedbackin support of aligning the individual/complete withdrawal dates and establishing a deadline later in the semester
- There is no financial impact sesciated with changing the widrawal deadlines no refunds are issued after the op deadline Financial Aidand the Bursa's Office will not be affected
- Dineen commented that UGC is supportive of the idea to move the withdrawal deadline to 95% of the semester, as suggested in the Regissrouffice proposal.
- The goal would be to start the new withdrawat ctice in Fall 2021.
- A policy needs to be written upbefore APC makes a recommendation Senate.
