

Notes –

1. One of the following, HIST 100/101, 120/121, HIST 110/112/113/114/115/118 may also be applied toward the Liberal Arts Curriculum in History.
2. Two of these four required social science courses (ECON 203, GEOG 100, PSCI 100) may be applied toward the Liberal Arts Curriculum in Social and Behavioral Sciences.
3. HIST 110/112/113/114/115/118/120/121, ANT 110 or GEOG 100 may also be applied towards the International Studies requirement in the Liberal Arts Curriculum.
4. In addition to the required courses, each major will also take 24 additional hours of electives, 200 level or above.
 - a. At least three credits must be taken in each of the three geographic areas (Europe, United States, Africa/Asia/Latin America/World).
 - b. Of the remaining 15 hours, no more than 9 can be taken in any one of the the three geographic areas
 - c. At least 18 of the 24 hours must be taken from courses numbered 300 or 400.
5. History majors must obtain a grade of "C" or better in all courses required for the major at UNC. Majors receiving a grade of "D+" or lower must retake the course- or an equivalent approved by the academic advisor- and receive a grade of "C-" or better to have the course counted toward the major.
6. All history courses numbered 300 or higher
